Faith In Action

“What you need to know for better health”

Innovative series about best practices in managing your health and safety

“What you need to know for better health,” is a series of free public programs in Deerfield and Highland Park on Tuesdays in May. The series features seminars in each location about how to navigate the health system successfully, communicating effectively with health care professionals and best practices in using medications and living alone safely.

Sponsored by Southeast Lake County Faith in Action Volunteers and supported by grants from the Health Care Foundation of Highland Park and West Deerfield Township, the sessions will be lead by Dr. Susan Levy, Professor Emerita, Univ. of Illinois of Chicago and nationally recognized expert on health literacy, and Dr. Audrey Gordon, nationally recognized expert in end of life care and gerontology and Executive Director of SELCFIA. There will be time for discussion.

The sessions will be held from 1:30-2:30 p.m. at the Deerfield Public Library (920 Waukegan Road) on May 5 and May 19 and at the Highland Park Recreation Center (1207 Park Avenue West) on May 12 and May 26.

The topics cover:

- (May 5 and 12). Communicating appropriately with health professionals, creating your family history, maintaining health records and your rights and responsibilities in using health services.
- (May 19 and 26). Proper use of medications, drug interactions and the importance of dosage and your medication history.

The program supports the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' initiative to improve health literacy nationally. HHS defines health literacy as "the degree to which individuals have the capacity to obtain, process and understand basic health information and services needed to make appropriate health decisions." It includes the ability to understand instructions on prescription drug bottles, appointment slips, medical education brochures, doctor's directions and consent forms, and the ability to negotiate complex health care systems.
